**HENRY "HANK" DELGADO TENORIO**  
1937 – 2001



The tournament was first created by Hank Tenorio and NLPOA Founder Vicente Calderon in 1992. Since Hank's passing in 2001, the NLPOA continues to host the event in his honor. Hank was a retired FBI agent, inspirational colleague, leader, mentor, friend and family member, who tirelessly gave back to the community.

Henry Delgado Tenorio was born on July 15, 1937 in Torrington, Wyoming where his family had been harvesting sugar beet crops. Henry coming from a less fortunate family graduated from Benedictine College (B.S.) and the University of Texas at El Paso (M.A.) He then joined the FBI in 1970. During his tenure as an FBI Agent, Henry specialized in kidnapping, anti-terrorism, bank robberies and hostage/crisis management. He became a liaison between the San Diego office and law enforcement agencies in Tijuana and Ensenada. This led to solving cases that would have been more difficult without his involvement. When he retired in 1994 he was the highest ranking Hispanic undercover agent in the FBI's San Diego office.

Henry's other passions were golf and community service. During his FBI career, he won several Police Olympics golf tournaments. Later, as a security consultant for the PGA tour, he befriended such pros as Lee Trevino and Chi Chi Rodriguez, once serving as a caddie for the latter. He later operated the Dos Amigos Foundation, which Mr. Rodriguez founded to raise funds for underprivileged children and orphanages in Mexico

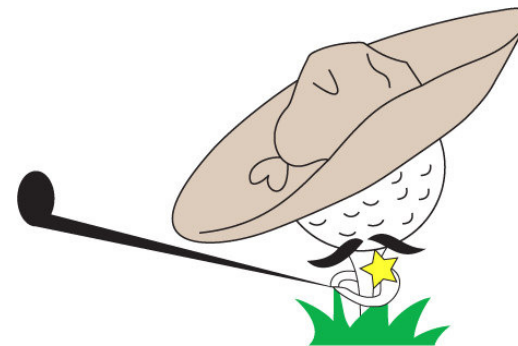
