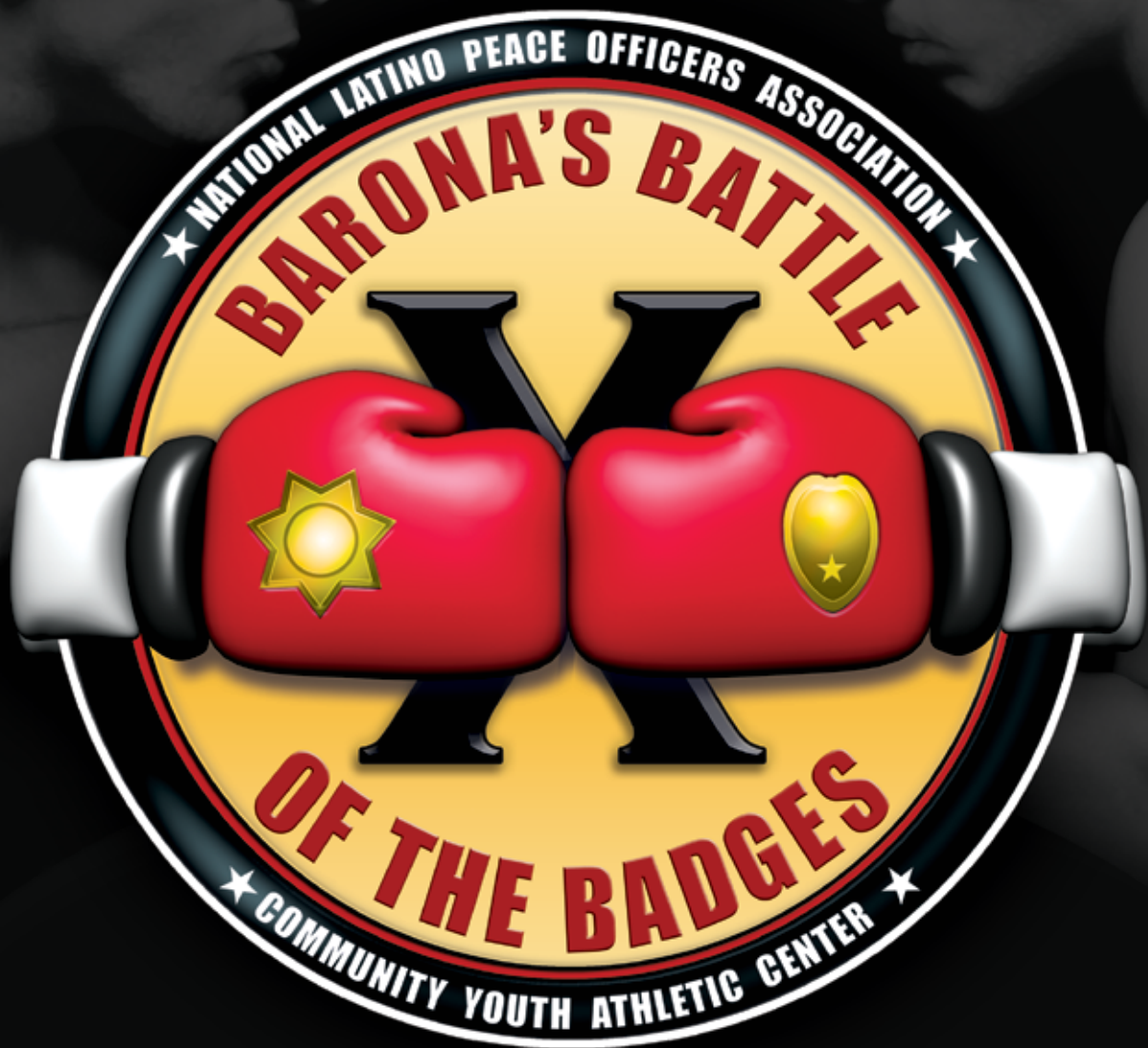

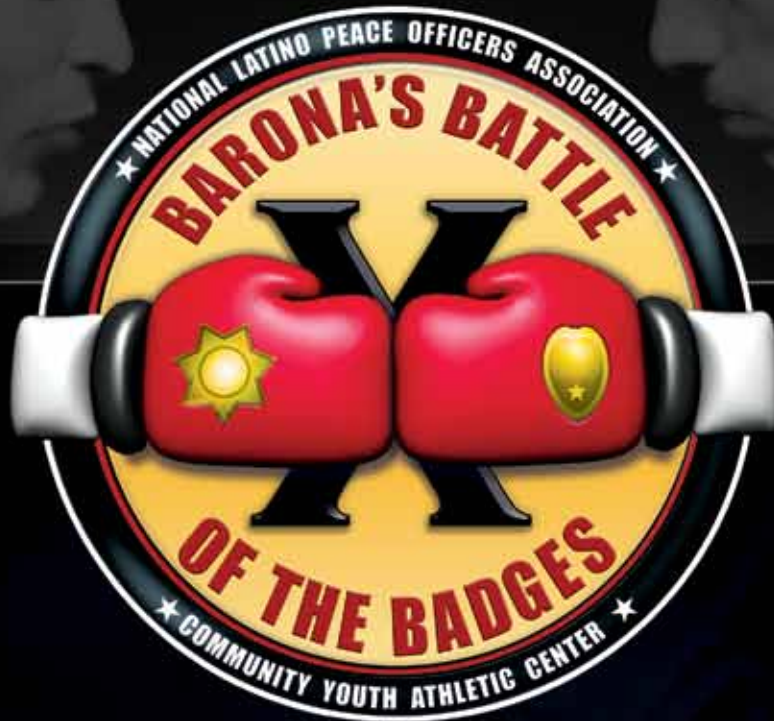

**HELPIN' HANDS COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAM**

The Helpin' Hands program gives area youth the opportunity to become real assets to their community. They participate in community clean-ups, help out in cultural celebrations, and do those things that teach a lifelong lesson: they can make a difference for good.



**BOXING AND FITNESS PROGRAM**

Through CYAC's Amateur Boxing and Fitness Program boys and girls, age 8 to 18, participate in a highly structured regimen aimed at addressing their physical fitness needs. Boxing is the centerpiece of their workouts, which include bag work, running, and calisthenics. With the guidance of experienced and trained coaches, youngsters develop self-worth and respect for others.



**EDUCATIONAL ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM**

CYAC maintains close contact with parents and schools on every participant's academic progress. USA Boxing and law enforcement have made available scholarship opportunities for youth involved in the program. CYAC has a volunteer tutor present at the center to help with home work and school studies, all directed at cultivating in the youngsters a strong desire to succeed in life.



**TTAAG - TEENS TAKING ACTION AGAINST GRAFFITI**

This is a collaborative effort between the City of National City Graffiti Abatement Program, San Diego County Probation Department and CYAC. The TTAAG Project is designed to make a positive, lasting impact on the visual and physical environment of our National City neighborhoods, while teaching young people the value of the environment around them.
